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New e-Payment for Residential College Laundry

Many residents are excited to see the availability of new commercial graded washers and dryers in the Residential College. And they are more excited to use a new e-Payment service developed by ITSC for the RC washers and dryers!

In the past, residents used their Octopus card to pay via a kiosk inside the laundry room to start a washer or dryer. Unfortunately, the kiosk failed frequently and some residents could not start the washer/dryer even after payment.



ITSC helped RCU set up a new system based on “Internet of Things (IOT)” technologies. To simply put, all washers/dryers are connected to our network, and we can monitor and control each washer/driver via a software application.

Residents can now:

1. Check the availability of machines before they go to the laundry room,
2. Select a washer/dryer, and
3. Pay by e-coupon to start a machine



The Government is promoting Hong Kong as a Smart City. ITSC note that this is a good example how we could improve our lives with smart technologies!

Increased RC International Bandwidth

Residents complained that the Internet speed was slow, especially after the opening of game ports. It was suggested that ITSC would explore ways to improve the Internet performance. One suggestion was to use a quota scheme for fair use. If a resident consumes more than 60GB of traffic, his/her bandwidth will be reduced to maximum of 2.5Mbps until next month.

ITSC implemented the scheme for two months and observed that the scheme was not effective at all. The bandwidth was saturated at 80-100% from 18:00 to 04:00, with or without the quota scheme (Image 1).

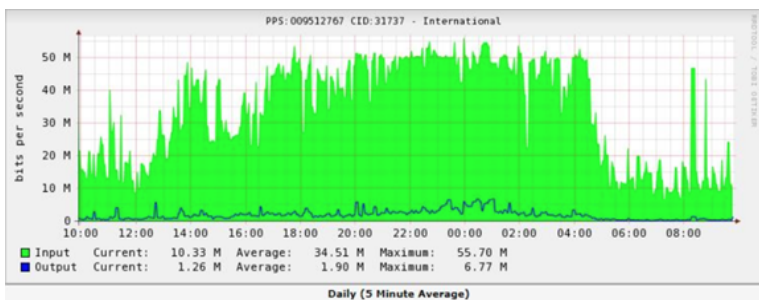

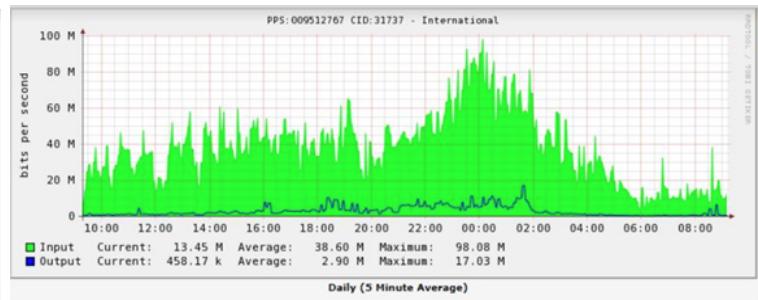

With a proposal from ITSC, RCU purchased an additional 50Mbps international bandwidth on April 19, 2018. The bandwidth usage now drops to 30-60% even at peak hours (Image 2). RC residents now experience a great improvement on network speed!

Centralized Virus Detection Service

Centralized Virus Detection Service is a system actively scanning all our campus PCs for

If you suspect that you have your computer or files infected by malware, please contact us immediately.

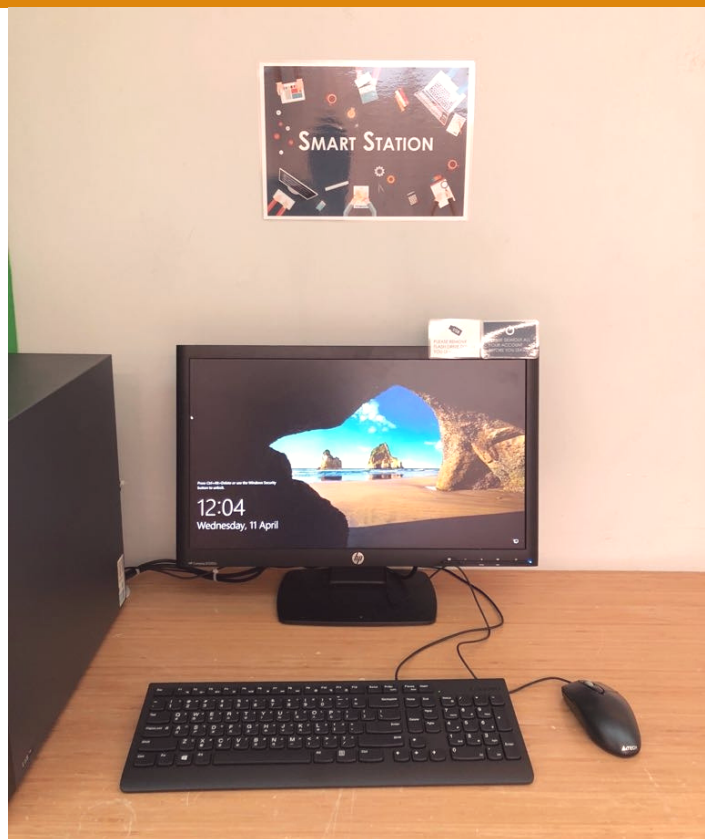
Launch of Smart Stations
