








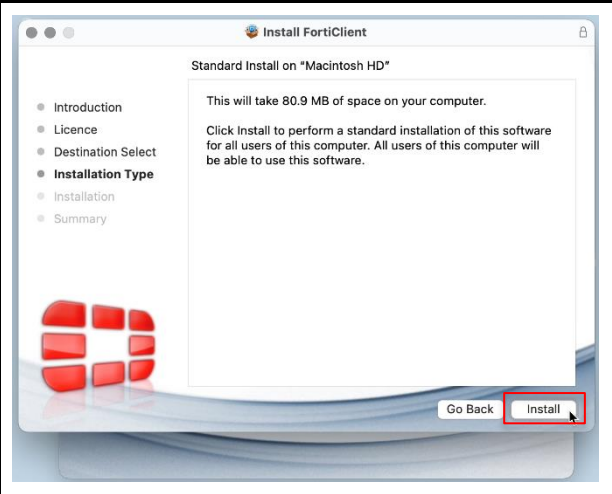
#	Steps	Screens
1.	Install the program from <a href="#">ITSC website</a> .	
2.	Click <b>“FortiClient”</b> from the desktop.	
3.	Click <b>“Install”</b> .	



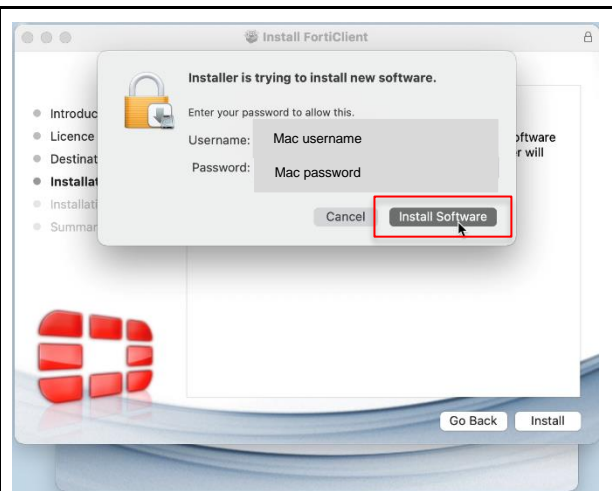
4.	Click <b>“Continue”</b> .

6.	Click <b>“Agree”</b> .	



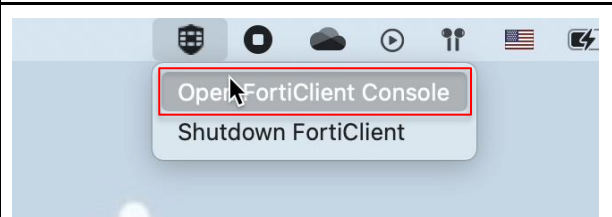
7. Click “Install”.





8. Enter your Mac account username and password to allow and install the software.






9. Click the VPN icon on the top of menu bar. Choose “Open FortiClient Console”.

<p>12.</p>	<p>Input the settings:</p> <p><b>Connection Name:</b> HSUHK <b>Remote Gateway:</b> sslvpn.hsu.edu.hk <b>Port:</b> 443 <b>Authentication:</b> Save login <b>Username:</b> MYHSUHK username (e.g. sxxxxxx for sxxxxxx@hsu.edu.hk)</p> <p>Click "Save".</p>	
<p>13</p>	<p>Enter <b>MYHSUHK Password</b> and click "<b>Connect</b>".</p>	
<p>14</p>	<p>Once connected, you may now access HSUHK internal resources through the SSLVPN service.</p>	



15 To disconnect SSLVPN, click the FortiClient icon at the top of menu bar, choose “**Disconnect HSUHK**”
